## School Goals For Student Learning

In 4th grade ELA we will focus on reading and comprehension and improve math facts and fluency.

1. **Reading Goal:** Using the 2023 GA Milestones Lexile scores, students in 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade will have a 3% increase in reading levels 2, 3, and 4.
2. **ELA Goal:** Using the 2023 GA Milestones ELA scores, students in 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade will have a 3% increase in ELA levels 2,3, and 4.
3. **Math Goal:** Using the 2023 GA Milestones Math scores, students in 3rd, 4th & 5th grade will have a 3% increase in math levels 2, 3, and 4.

### CSE 4th Grade Students

CSE students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed and reach for the stars in reading, math, and writing. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school:

- I will read 20 minutes each night. working toward A/R Goal
- Participate in class and complete assignments
- Practice multiplication to be fluent in facts 1-12
